





KRIS HOPKINS ON Facing the challenges that lie Ahead

Despite Germany, France and Japan all coming out of recession in recent weeks. the United Kinadom continues to suffer from the economic downturn and the effects of this are clearly being felt here as much as anywhere else in the country.

As a local boy educated at Oakworth Grammar School and Keighley College, I am particularly conscious of the impact it is having on young people in the area.

A recent report published by the Prince's Trust revealed that unemployment amongst 18 to 24-year-olds across Bradford district had risen by 61 per cent in the last year. Additionally, it claimed that one in five young people who have iust received their GCSE results could be forced on to the dole queue by the age of 21. These are startling and depressing facts. Sadly, this recession has left our younger generation facing the gloomiest outlook with regard to jobs since the 1929 economic crash. Companies have been forced to shed jobs or close altogether and, even when the economic downturn finally comes to an end, this trend is likely to continue for some considerable time afterwards.

Whilst young people may be powerless to do anything about the bigger economic picture, they can commit themselves to getting the qualifications and skills they need to enable them to get a good job as soon as the situation improves.

Working with the schools, local education

providers must also never stop considering what more can be done to give young people the chance to succeed in the classroom and in the world of work which will follow - and then they must act.


And the parents must also challenge their children and, crucially, be prepared to be challenged themselves.

My proudest moment as the Conservative Prospective Parliamentary Leader of Bradford Council came earlier this year helped

launch the "b someone" campaign to boost skills and educational attainment across the district. The primary focus of the initiative is to encourage adults to help develop children's educational skills by spending time with them and making learning fun. Life for all of us can be hectic but by involving children in everyday learning activities, such as reading, counting, cooking and playing, and making them fun and interesting, youngsters can undoubtedly come on in leaps and bounds.

Aside from parents, grandparents and other adults can also have a massive influence on a child's life, especially when it comes to learning and developing skills. For example, shopkeepers can play their part by asking young customers to work out their change rather than simply handing them a fistful of coins.

So, whilst we are obviously going through a difficult economic period at present, it is a time for all of us locally - young people in particular - to stand tall and aspire together rather than putting our collective heads in the sand.



A delicious dinner dish which celebrates the best of the harvest - and great for showing off the fruits of your allotment or vegetable patch.

Don't be put off by the thought of making enough dish, and that it is well greased.

- 450g courgettes, peeled and diced
- 450ml milk
- salt and pepper
- pinch of grated nutmeg
- 3 eggs

• about 1kg of a mix of your favourite root "soufflé" – just make sure you have a deep vegetables and/or sgashes- carrot, swede, sweet potato, squash, peeled and chopped into 2-3cm chunks

- 3-4 oz pearl barley, soaked and cooked
- according to the instructions on the packet • 2 vegetable stock cubes
- Pre-heat oven to gas mark 6, 200 electric or 190 fan)

First, prepare the pearl barley - it usually needs soaking and cooking for at least an hour and a half.

Lightly cook the vegetables for around 10 minutes, and then place with the barley in the bottom of the soufflé dish. Warm 150 ml of the milk and melt the stock cubes into it - pour over the vegetables

Cook the courgettes in half a pint of milk with salt, pepper and nutmeg over a low heat until very soft, and then pour off half the remaining milk in the pan. Puree the courgettes with a whisk, blender or by mashing it and then pushing it through a sieve with a spoon. Allow to cool and check the seasoning - it often needs a little extra salt and pepper.

Separate the eggs and stir the yolks into the courgette puree. Whisk the egg whites until they are firm, and stir a tablespoon or two into the puree. Then add the rest of the whites and fold them in with a figure of eight shape (don't beat them as the air will come out and you will get scrambled eggs!)

Pile the mix on top of the vegetables and reduce ovenheat to 170 [150 fan] or gas mark 3, and bake for around 40 minutes. Do try not to peep! You can keep it longer in the oven if it still seems a little runny - just cover the top with some greaseproof paper to prevent it burning.



LILIES OF THE VALLEY is a new local charity run by a group of women from different churches in Keighley. The newly renovated and refurbished premises at No 72.

Cavendish Street opens its doors to the public September 2nd. The drop-in centre for mothers provides a very attractive, safe, and warm venue in which women can meet, enjoy homemade cakes and feed their babies.

Over the past 16 months No 72 has been transformed from a rather antiquated retail premises into a modern, light and airy space. Central heating, a disabled toilet and baby changing facility and a new fire alarm system have all been installed, as well as new flooring.

The trustees of LILIES OF THE VALLEY feel that the provision of this facility will

benefit many mothers in our community, particularly because of its central location, and being so near to the bus station and shopping centre. They know from personal experience that being a mum can be far from easy and is potentially very isolating. A meeting place such as this can go a long way in bringing women together who can encourage one another.

The drop-in centre is run by volunteers who passionately believe that women need to be valued and supported in their role as mothers. The Christian ethos of the centre will emphasise this and will welcome all mums, regardless of race or creed. No 72 is keen to signpost to other agencies in Keighley, and has begun to network already with some of these.

No 72 will initially be open on Wednesdays at 12.30-2.30pm, and Thursdays, 10-12pm. Donations are gratefully received for the refreshments, and mums are invited to ring the doorbell on arrival!


