COUNTRY COOKING & FORAGING FOR FOOD

For the promotion of Health & Wellbeing by Cath Bromwich



We have shown off the splendour of where we live to the world this summer and what better way to continue to do this than to serve up on a

plate the colours and flavours of our dales! As summer roles into autumn I want to share with you a very traditional way of doing this. Look out for those vibrant rowanberries that you see blazing on the trees which line the dales that a couple of months ago held the worlds' attention. It always intrigues me that the best flavours to accompany meats seem to grow from the same land. Rowanberry is our cranberry and, for me, is very much the fruit that turns the seasons. The fruit varies in colour depending on the weather and ranges from yellow through orange to red.

Like other forgeable fruits there are some tricky aspects to rowanberries. They are high in pectin so can set very solid! The pips cause indigestion so making jelly is a good option. The juice is rather bitter. It is a savoury flavour and the jelly goes well with game, especially venison, and traditionally mutton. I've just seen it advertised with bacon and black pudding, could be a winner!

The jelly can be made alone or with other fruits. Crab apple is a good combination but both fruits are high in pectin so take care! As with the more common red currant jelly you can use it unadulterated on the side of your plate or added to gravy. Another nice thing to do with it is to glaze over a fruit tart. Additionally, you can add the berries to other fruit to make sweet jams.

People used to brew the juices up in various ways. I don't find the idea of Rowan wine appealing but would try a beer! An interesting sounding alternative I have just found is a recipe for rowan lemonade. I will share this with you

once I have tested it. For now you can squeeze a few drops of the juice into your gin and tonic as an alternative to Angostura bitters! Top tip: try making different flavours by adding a bit of different fruit to the recipe e.g. apple or blackberry.

Rowanberry Jelly

Pick as many berries as you are happy to. Pick them before they are very ripe. At home wash and destalk.



Put in a jam making pan with a little water and simmer for a while, mashing a little. You can keep simmering beyond the time

the fruit breaks down. This will continue to extract the flavour. Strain the juice out through muslin or an old pillow case. I suspend mine under a chair and let the juice drip into a bowl overnight. Measure the juice. For every 1 pint of juice add 1LB of ordinary sugar to a clean pan. Before you bring to the boil I would get your sterilized jars and covers all ready. My experience is that this jelly reaches gelling point VERY suddenly and quickly so don't lose concentration unless you want a new type of household adhesive!! Bring to the boil, simmer, skim any scum off. Test for gelling point by spooning a little onto a cool saucer, leave a minute and then draw your finger through. If the juice wrinkles then quickly take off the heat and decant into your jars.

Keighley & Worth Valley Railway

It is difficult to convey the amount of work that goes on behind the scenes to operate the Railway, but it was exemplified in the fantastic efforts of our 97 rostered volunteers who ran the Railway when The Le grandest of Grand Departs cycled its way from Keighley, past the station at Haworth and on to Oxenhope.

We carried passengers from just after 6am to nearly 9pm, operating our most intensive timetable ever, with three steam engines and two diesel locomotives in use for much of the day. It was great to part of the marvellous atmosphere that Le Tour de France generated and I am looking forward to working with our partners to ensure that we find ways to benefit from the legacy of the event.

We have continued the Anglo-Francais theme, with this week seeing the first test journey on the branch line for a locomotive that has not run for well over twenty years. The steam locomotive 'City of Wells' is actually Southern Railway by birth in 1949, but it was brought to the Railway by its owners so many decades ago, and thanks in no small part to its then futuristic

design with a very distinctive streamlined boiler-casing, it is always a favourite with passengers and we look forward to the loco joining the operational fleet shortly. To explain its French connection, in its time operating on Southern metals, it would have hauled 'The Golden Arrow' or 'flèche d'Or' service, the luxury boat trains that ran from London to Dover where passengers would take a ferry to Calais and a connecting service to Paris. It takes a huge commitment and amount of energy to work on such a long-term restoration project, especially when working on a voluntary basis, by a very small team of dedicated expert enthusiasts, but the fruits of their labour of love is a joy to behold.

We are now running seven days per week over the summer holidays and I do hope that you will be able to take advantage of the discount offered to local residents and travel with us soon. **Details of local residents' discounts and train times can be found on www.kwvr.co.uk Latest news on City of Wells' progress can be found on the Railway's news feed: worthnews.wordpress.com**

BIG HILLS, BIG HEARTS, BIG ON FAIRTRADE

As the numerous decorated bikes and flags come down, and road graffiti fades, the district is gradually returning to normal after the huge excitement of 'le tour'. The buzz all around remained long after the cycles raced through and it's doubtful that anyone escaped being uplifted and proud. *It's not over yet!*

One of the criteria to be a Fairtrade Village or Town is awareness raising and we used this opportunity to make a short video along with Fairtrade Bradford and Fairtrade Yorkshire with help from Keighley Town Centre Association who are part of Keighley's relatively new but very successful Fairtrade group.

It was one of the most ambitious projects we have been involved in but is proving to be one of the most successful.

Using a local videographer, Danny Hardaker, and inviting supporters from the wider community to take part, the shoot day went well despite a little rain, the banana suited cyclists did us proud and the resulting film created a celebration of what we do and have achieved. With the film now circulating on Youtube and Vimeo, the Fairtrade message is being shared and commented on as we showcase our impressive scenery and caring communities. Although the film was to promote Fairtrade

campaigning throughout Yorkshire, comprising of 34 Fairtrade Towns so far, we were fortunate that Haworth's Main Street and towards Oxenhope was chosen for the location. What we didn't know at the time though was that the iconic street scene would also be the official main photo featuring in the National and International press.

So, as for the Grand Depart legacy, the film will carry on being shared and will be screened at high profile events, the message will reach many more thousands across the globe. Compliments have been received from Poland, USA, South Africa, India plus many more as others are inspired to follow our example.

The other significant achievement for the group, mainly due to the work of Chris Upton from West Lane Baptist Church, is the 'Welcome to Haworth, the Word's First Fairtrade Village' signs, erected just in time for the global event.

Men of Worth and the new Centenary Project

The Men of Worth Project aims to document all details of every single man and woman from Keighley and the Worth Valley who served our country in conflict. Our main aim at the moment is documenting those who served in the Great War. We are mindful, however, that the numbers of veterans who served in World War two is diminishing with each day so we are also focussing on those people as well.

We are creating a permanent archive of the men and women of Keighley and the Worth Valley area who served their country in the armed forces, from the earliest records to the present day.

Much of this information is available of our website at www.menofworth.org.uk and we have an online form for people to submit details of relatives, for us to follow up with research in archives to create a complete picture.

We need people will come forward with photographs, letters and postcards from the front and any other information not usually found in public archives. We will then copy and return these items, carry out our own research on the person and add this research to the

personal items to create a unique biography of each person. This will become part of a lasting and publicly accessible digital archive which will be freely available.

We put on exhibitions and displays and attend local events and shows, and give talks about the Project.

The Project began in 2004 with research on the Oakworth War Memorial. Because people have always moved around in their lives, we found that people were often named on more than one local memorial because their family may not have lived where they did and they wanted their relative's name on a memorial which was near to them. A man could be from Oakworth but actually be named on the Riddlesden memorial because that was where his mother lived. Our research soon spread to include other local memorials and eventually we thought a limit had to be set. The natural boundaries of the Worth Valley seemed to be a reasonable line to draw, so we settled with that.

We cover from Silsden and Steeton to Riddlesden and Morton; Thwaites and Long Lee, Crossroads and Lees, Haworth, Oxenhope, Stanbury and Oldfield; Oakworth and Newsholme, Slippery Ford, Goose Eye, Laycock and Utley; and all the areas of Keighley such as Braithwaite, Parkwood, Worth Village, Eastwood, Showfield, Highfield, West Lane, Ingrow, Hermit Hole, Wheathead and Exley Head.

The Men of Worth Project became "The Men of Worth Project C.I.C." (Community Interest Company) in June 2013 with Directors Helen Wade, Ian Walkden and Andy Wade.

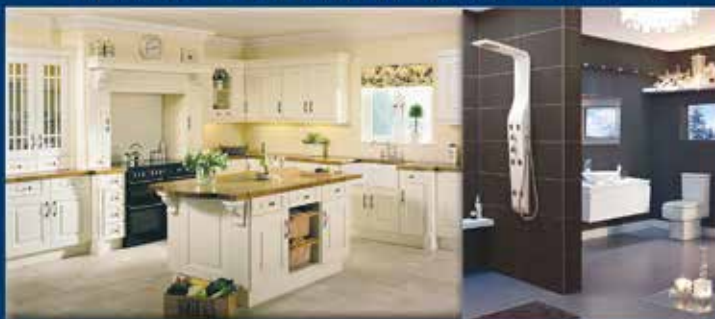
