

OUR FAMILY FAVOURITES

Favourite family recipes from our friends and neighbours in the beautiful Worth and Aire Valleys. This month's recipe comes from Tracey Darley. Tracey and her husband Paul moved to Haworth recently having lived and travelled all over the world. According to Tracey, Haworth is her "Goldilocks" village: It's "just right" in almost every way.

Aunty Barb's Christmas Mince

One of my most precious childhood memories is doing Christmas baking in my Aunty Barb's farm kitchen. Mince pies were always a particular favourite, filled with her delicious homemade mince. This recipe is so simple to make that I never reach for a jar of the store bought variety! No matter where I am at Christmas time, this Christmas mince makes my mince pies taste like "home."

Ingredients

250g raisins 250g currants 250g sultanas 125g candied peel 500g grated apple (peel and core) 500g brown sugar 250g grated butter or suet (I use butter) 1/2 tsp each ground nutmeg, cinnamon & ginger 1/4 to 1/2 tsp ground cloves 250ml brandy

Method

Place all of the ingredients in a large bowl and mix well using a wooden spoon until the sugar has dissolved and the butter and apple are incorporated and evenly distributed through the mixture. For a finer mixture you can lightly pulse it in a food processor, but I like it just as it is. Fill the jars and refrigerate the Christmas Mince to use in your favourite Christmas Mince pie recipe.

This recipe makes about four medium jars of mince; plenty for all your mince pie needs, with maybe a jar or two to give away as gifts. This year, I chose to decorate my jars with homemade beeswax wraps. If you'd like to learn to make these wraps yourself, why not join one of the **Beeswax wrap workshops** taking place in Haworth at "Upstairs at Pennybank" on **7th and I4th December.** Visit the Upstairs at Pennybank Facebook page for more details or contact Tracey on 07742 983 608.

Now that we are in December, I think it's acceptable to talk more openly about Santa! He joins us at the Keighley and Worth Valley Railway from the end of November right up to Christmas Eve, after which Father Christmas has a pressing commitment to get ready for the big day itself.We will welcome over 10,000 passengers to the Railway during the month of Santa Specials and it takes hundreds of volunteers to look after him and his Pixies, as well as set up the fantastic **Winter Wonderland** at Oxenhope. The trains will also be decorated for the festive season, as well the stations, and even if you have not booked for the Santa Specials trains, you can still enjoy the festive atmosphere right up until New Year's Day, because we reopen the Railway for the ever-popular **Mince Pie Specials,** which run from Boxing Day to New Years' Day. Full details of the remaining seats on the Santa Specials, as well as times and fares for the Mince Pie services are all available on the website.

Whilst Christmas is here and for many that means a break, running the Railway is a yearround endeavor, and whilst the trains don't run on Christmas Day itself, they start again on Boxing Day, as does the continuing effort to maintain and overhaul the increasingly elderly infrastructure, rolling stock and locomotives. Behind the scenes we have dozens of volunteers working away to restore the fleet and to work on the track, and you will often see members of the Civil gang - wearing high visibility bright orange clothing for their safety when working on the line – out and about across the Railway undertaking their various duties, whatever



the worst of the Yorkshire weather throws at them. A significant project that will take a huge amount of volunteer effort, as well as significant amounts of cash, is the planned replacement of one of the bridges on the line.

Seeing the festive passengers enjoying meeting Santa on board is fantastic, because it's a reminder to all of us who are part of the 700+ active volunteers of why we do what we do. Keeping such an important part of history alive, especially when it's appreciated by such young visitors who will never have experienced steam trains on the main line, makes it all so worthwhile. I do hope that we can welcome you on board soon, whether as a passenger or to our volunteer team. There's details on the website on how to get involved as a volunteer, and if you are wanting to travel and you live in BD20/21.22, don't forget that you can benefit from a Local **Resident's Railcard.**

A Railcard is valid for one adult – the one whose name and photo appears on it. Each Adult can take with them up to 3 children aged 5 to 15 inclusive at around half the local resident adult fare.





Thanks to the support of hundreds of people, including many residents of Haworth and the surrounding area, Charlotte's little book is coming home! We were very touched by everyone's generosity and messages of encouragement during the campaign. We received comments from people from all over the world, many who said how much they loved Haworth and had very fond memories of visiting, even if it was a very long time ago. Comments like those showed us that many people shared our conviction that Charlotte's little book should return to Haworth, and made us all the more determined to make that happen. There has been a flurry of renewed media interest in the Brontës and the Parsonage and we're looking forward to welcoming many new visitors in 2020. At the time of writing, the little book is still in Paris, but its papers (and passport!) are ready and we expect it to arrive in Haworth before the end of the year. As local residents will be aware, the Museum is closed for conservation work in January, but when we reopen on I February 2020, we hope to have this very special acquisition on display. Traditional Moscow Mule

Ingredients: 2 oz vodka l oz fresh lime juice Ginger beer Lime wedge for garnish Mint for garnish

Method: Fill two copper mugs with ice. Pour I ounce of vodka and .5 ounce of lime juice over the ice in each mug. Top up with ginger beer until mostly full. Stir. Garnish with lime and mint.
