#### Chicken Liver Pâté Ingredients

250g chicken livers 250g unsalted butter

2 tbsp brandy

2 garlic cloves, crushed

1/2 tsp mixed spice

2 tsp chopped fresh thyme leaves

2 tsp mustard powder

Sea salt, Freshly ground black pepper

#### Method

Melt 50g of the butter over a medium heat in a sauté pan.

Add the chicken livers and fry gently for about 5 minutes, stirring regularly, until just cooked through.

Transfer the livers to a blender or food processor using a slotted spoon.

Pour the brandy into the hot pan and let it bubble for a few seconds, scraping up any caramelised bits. Add 150g of butter and the garlic, and cook until the butter is foaming. Pour this mixture into the blender. Add the mixed spice, mustard powder and thyme, then season well with salt and black pepper.

Blend until completely smooth, then pour into a suitably sized earthenware pot or dish.

Melt the remaining butter and pour it over the surface of the pâté to seal.

Once cool, cover and chill in the fridge for up to two days. Serve with hot buttered toast and pickled gherkins.

#### **Celeriac and Apple Soup**

(Use olive oil and vegetable stock instead of butter and chicken stock for a vegan version.)

#### Ingredients

75g butter, or 2 tbsp olive oil

I large Spanish onion, chopped

2 garlic cloves, peeled and crushed

I large celeriac, peeled and cut into large dice

I large potato, peeled and cut into large dice

I large carrot, peeled and sliced

3-4 red dessert apples, peeled, cored and sliced

2 dried bay leaves

2 tsp chopped thyme leaves

Sea salt & Freshly ground black pepper

1.5 litres chicken or vegetable stock

Freshly chopped parsley

A couple of dollops of crème fraîche or soured cream

#### Method

Melt the butter (or heat the oil) in a large pot over a medium heat. Add the onion and garlic and cook gently, stirring occasionally, until soft but not coloured.

Add the celeriac, potato, carrot and apples. Cook over a medium-low heat for about 15 minutes, stirring occasionally to prevent sticking or browning.

Add the bay leaves and thyme, season with salt and pepper, and cook for another couple of minutes.

Pour in the stock, bring to a gentle simmer, cover and cook for 30 minutes.

Remove the bay leaves and blend the soup until smooth with a hand-held stick blender.

Check the seasoning and add a little hot water if needed to adjust the consistency.

Serve with a spoonful of crème fraîche and a scattering of chopped parsley.

# BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE MUSEUM

As 2025 starts to come to a close, I'm looking back on some of the highlights of the year. I started my role as Marketing and Development Officer at the Brontë Parsonage Museum in March this year, and so much has happened in such a short time! Not long after I started at the Museum, we had the exciting delivery of The North Wind, an 1842 watercolour painting by Emily Brontë from her time in Brussels. Being in the Parsonage library when The North Wind was unwrapped was an unforgettable experience, although the painting wasn't painted in Haworth it felt almost like a homecoming and I was surprised to find that it was quite an emotional experience. There was a hush as Ann Dinsdale, our Principal Curator, peeled back the final protective layer, followed by lots of 'oohs' and 'aahs' as we saw, for the first time in person, the still vibrant colours of the painting. I'm looking forward to seeing The North Wind on display for the first time in 2026.

Another highlight for me was the loan of the Emily Brontë portrait from the National Portrait Gallery. Painted by Branwell Brontë, and originally part of a large group painting, this truly was a homecoming and to see the portrait in its original home was incredible. Before the Museum opened, and before the crowds, I thought I would sneak off into the exhibition space to have a quiet moment, only to find that several of my colleagues had the same idea!

Even though I've been reflecting on the year, we do still have some really exciting events coming up! Join us online on Thursday 18 December for The Brontë Lounge with Eleanor Houghton, where we'll discuss the



inspiration behind Eleanor's upcoming book, Charlotte Brontë's Life Through Clothes, which turns to the gowns, bonnets, corsets, boots, and mittens in Charlotte's wardrobe for clues about the famous author's life. Then on Friday 19 December you can join us inperson for Parsonage Unwrapped: Treasures of the Collection which includes a session in the library to see unique Brontë items close up, and an exclusive private view of the Parsonage after hours.

In 2026 we'll be back with a whole new programme of events, and although we can't reveal too much just now, I can assure you that there will be something for everyone to look forward to. From all of us at the Brontë Parsonage Museum, we hope you have a merry Christmas, and we'll see you in the new year! ~ Hayley Pink


