There are also a range of specialist facilities including industry standard workshops for Welding & Fabrication, Carpentry & Joinery, Electrical Installation, and Plumbing & Gas Safety.

The Campus is also home to the STAR

Centre, a lively science hub that uses space as a theme to encourage young learners into undertaking science related subjects.

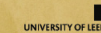
