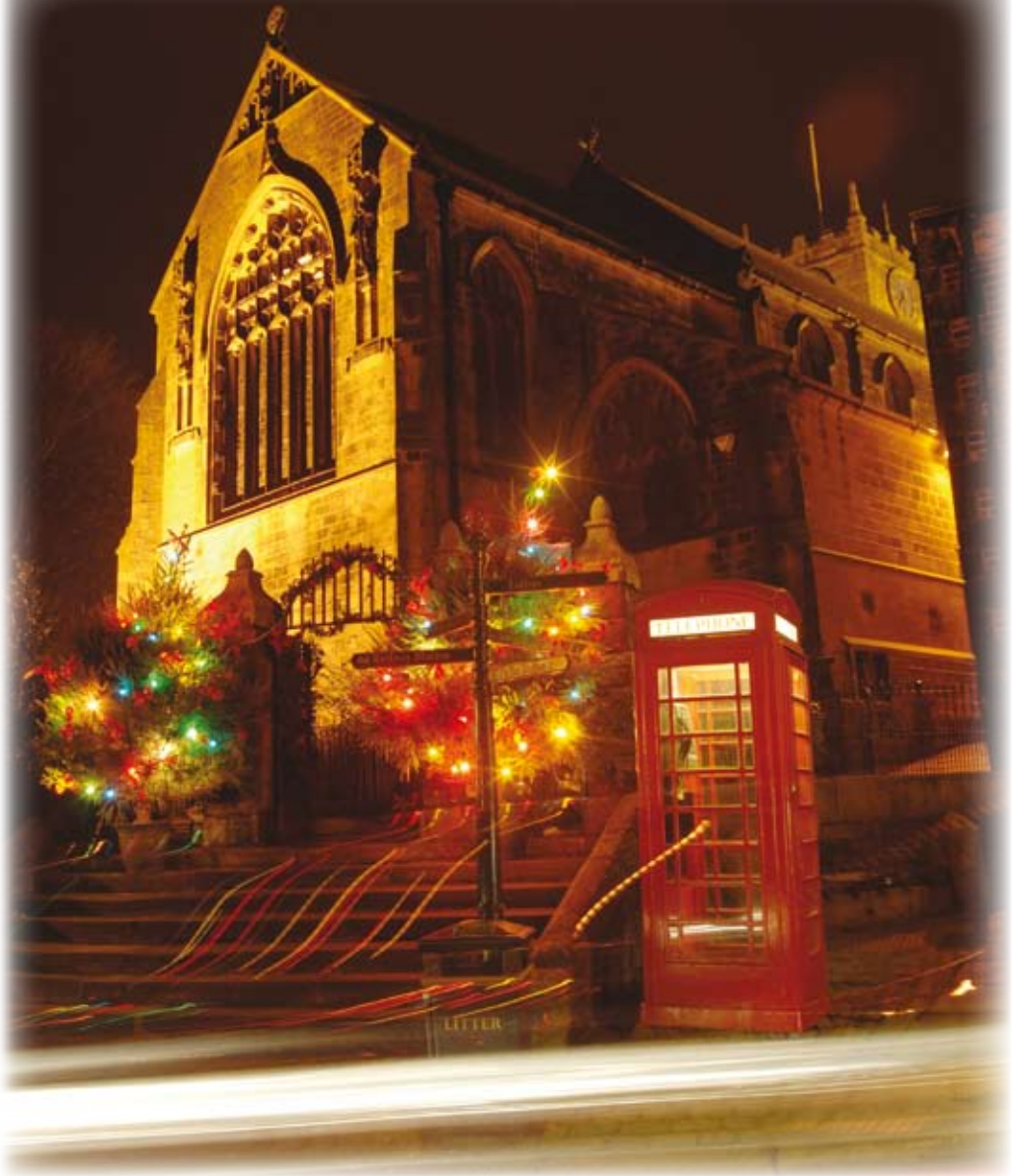

WINED & DINED
 BY CLAIRE SMITH


 At the time of writing, my oven, like some colossal womb, is in the process of nurturing several slowly rising rich brandy fruit cakes; the air in the kitchen is heavy with the scent of brandy, spices, the sweetness of glossy red cherries, the sharpness of candied citrus, the promise of christmas; of jewel encrusted branches, fireside gatherings, orange, cinnamon and cloves.
 We have reached the part of the year which hosts one of our most special celebrations. Winter solstice which falls on December 21st, the shortest day, heralds the turning of the year, the conveyance of warmth and light into the darkness of winter and the celebration of the cycle of ongoing life and re-birth.
 Unfortunately, christmas for many has become a time of burdensome obligation, a gorging on commercialism instead of a feasting on the magic and joy of life; but for me there is something truly delicious about planning and preparing for the festive season.
 I'm sure that a great many of us remember with affection, those special times spent in bustling kitchens where pans simmered, herbs were chopped, sauces and stuffings were prepared and the all important pudding was born.
 In our house we have certain traditions of which I am ferociously protective. Trimming the tree is one of them; for this occasion my girls and I gather together a few of our favourite nibbles on which to snack whilst we

decorate the tree by candlelight
 The combination of spicy mulled wine and roasted chestnuts encapsulates the spirit of christmas and is very easy to prepare yourself. Fresh chestnuts should be heavy, hard and like shiny polished mahogany in colour; you need to prick their skins to prevent them from exploding and bake them in a hot oven, before peeling the skins away and eating them - they should be sweet and soft.
 Infusing a good red wine with cinnamon, the zest and juice of an orange or lemon, cloves, ground mace or freshly grated nutmeg, juniper berries and a little demerara sugar will create an aromatic alcoholic drink which when served hot will lift the spirits. You can play around with the flavour, altering it according to your own taste.
 When it comes to the main event, if you are less than comfortable in the kitchen choose dishes which are manageable for you and which can be prepared ahead of time. Dauphinoise potatoes can be made in advance and are a delicious alternative to creamed or roast potatoes. The same applies to stuffings and sauces.
 The key to taking the pressure off at christmas is to allow yourself plenty of time to experiment and to create the kind of christmas you actually want. This should be a time spent weaving special magic around those close to us.
 Whether you love or loathe christmas, winter without a yuletide celebration of some kind would be like Narnia under the rule of the white witch.
 May I wish all of you a warm and wonderful christmas (both in and out of the kitchen) and a happy and healthy new year.

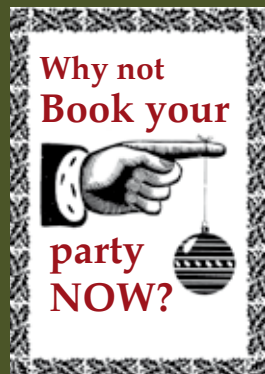

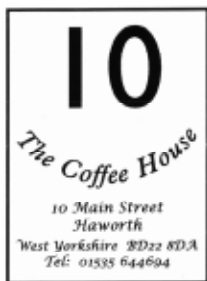

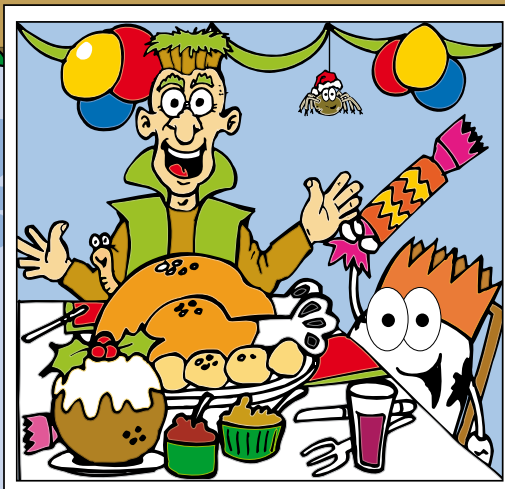
CHRISTMAS FRUITCAKE RECIPE

TINSEL AND TANDOORI

Christmas dinners are boring. Admit it - they're the same every year. Dry, tasteless turkey - as interesting as a new Cliff Richard single. Floppy carrots, lumpy potatoes, and worst of all ... sprouts. There's a reason why

they're only eaten once a year; they taste like someone else has already eaten them. But you force them down and try to smile, because it's Christmas.

But who's doing the cooking? Being named the Christmas Day cook is about as welcome as being the designated driver.

So, in the words of Jamie Oliver, "try something new this Christmas", let someone else do the cooking. Go for an Indian. It's not traditional, festive or what you usually do? Good.

If the 'Haworth Tandoori' could afford the type of advertising 'M&S' can, you'd get visions of (complete with a sexy, throaty voice-over) "expertly spiced, finely minced lamb, wrapped in crisp, freshly made samosa pastry" or "succulent, locally farmed chicken, covered with a creamy, buttery masala sauce". This curry house's advertising budget, thankfully, has been spent on other things. The service is exemplary, the atmosphere is warm and comfortable, the food is continuously exceptional and the 'King Prawn Sag', in particular, is fantastic.

But back to Christmas. You need something special - a centrepiece to make people ask: "What's a Turkey again?" The answer, this year, is the 'Kuresihi Lamb'.

Cooked beautifully with expertly chosen spices and keema, it is masterfully served in a gravy that will cause you to make that sound that you make when you're so happy that you're not sure what to do with your face - "aawwaahhh".

The meat on this whole leg of lamb, which comfortably serves four, slides off the bone as though it hasn't been cooked at all, but rubbed hot by Santa's elves, while they should've been making that 'Playstation' you couldn't afford. If the lamb alone is not enough, the side-dishes are varied and the accompaniments plentiful, and you can even take the whole lot away (something the brilliant staff will happily accommodate, so long as you bring their big dish back).

So, who needs turkey and sprouts?

Let's face it though. You're going to have turkey. You're going to have the floppy carrots and lumpy potatoes and, for some reason, you're going to have sprouts, because on Christmas day, that's what you do.

When it's all over though, and you're finished with the presents and the bloated feeling and the arguing and 'The Snowman', go try the lamb. A word of warning though: you must order it in advance. And book early, because this boxing day the 'Haworth Tandoori' will be packed!
